PRESENTATIONS

Agenda Item: 20-0713, CRA Capital Projects Update

Susan Kores, CRA Manager presented the update highlighting the Bridge Road project, Mapp Road Town Center Groundbreaking, and the Ripple project.

Josh Mills, CRA Project Manager presented updates on two completed projects: the Golden Gate Neighborhood Restoration project and the Safe Routes to School project in Port Salerno.

- C. Winters Are all the FPL poles coming out on the Bridge Road Project?
- S. Kores Yes. There will be one pole left in the back where the big transformer is located.
- S. Tsaftarides We are not getting credit for the projects. Commissioner Ciampi did not mention the CRA during the Mapp Road groundbreaking event.

NEW BUSINESS

Agenda Item: 20-0716, Rio Property Acquisition – 1275 NE Dixie Hwy

Susan Kores, CRA Manager presented the acquisition of 1275 NE Dixie Highway in Rio.

- C. Hall What is the plan for this property? Is it going to be resold and if it is sold, where does the money go?
- S. Kores We do not have a specific plan. Some of the possibilities include using this property as incentive or opportunity zone property. Either way the acquisition of this property will enhance the CRA. If sold, the money goes back into the Rio CRA Trust Fund.
- M. Palazzo What is the justification for the final sale price in excess of the appraisal of the \$360k? Does the county require multiple appraisals before acquiring a property?
- S. Kores We negotiated with the seller. The justification is that this is a large piece of property on the main street and works very well in our key property area.
- E. Lenihan This is the CRA purchasing the property and not The County. The CRA follows certain regulations and the County follow others. This board did approve a policy of 25% over the appraised value for acquiring properties in these key areas.
- M. Palazzo I am assuming the Rio NAC approved this purchase?
- S. Kores The Rio NAC has approved the property acquisition strategy and CIP.
- M. Readling How much do we have in the property acquisition trust fund for Rio?
- S. Kores Including 2021, we have \$650k available to buy property.
- J. Priest Representing the Rio Civic Club, this property is over an acre with 3 adjoining properties. It is
 time to go vertical in Rio with our redevelopment. We have done magnificent work with the infrastructure,
 but it is time to build and develop all 6 CRA's beginning with acquiring and developing this property. We
 need to start going up instead of across.
- S. Kores Purchasing property in the CRA's is a very elementary, but very important strategy to help us move things along.

MOTION

- * S. Tsaftarides motioned to approve the purchase of the property of real property at 1275 NE Dixie Highway in Rio and move that the agency adopt a resolution accepting and approving the deed and authorizing the CRA chair to sign all relevant documents
- ** M. Palazzo seconded, R. Kennedy opposed, and the motion carried 6 to 1.
- C. Hall The home on the property is 75 years old, but I am concerned about the cost of moving the home. This can be guite expensive, and I wouldn't want to see this cost fall on the CRA.
- S. Kores I am not sure what the house will be used for and I cannot guarantee who would be responsible for the cost of moving it.

Agenda Item: 20-0737, Office of Community Development FY 2021 Tentative Operating Budget Susan Kores, CRA Manager presented the tentative budget.

• C. Hall – I see the significant increase is that the retirement and health insurance are significantly higher than the last budget and we don't have any control over that.
