OLD BUSINESS

Agenda Item: 20-0483, Mapp Road Town Center Streetscape Update

Jordan Pastorius, Senior Project Manager, Martin County Office of Community Development, presented an update on the Mapp Road Town Center Streetscape Project.

- M. Palazzo – Was the Pre-bid meeting well represented?
- J. Pastorius – We had 4 or 5 vendors show up.
- R. Sentell – Were they from this area?
- J. Pastorius – Yes, Martin and surrounding counties.
- R. Sentell – Are you mandated to go with the lowest bid?
- J. Pastorius – No, but if we don't there has to be a very good reason why not.
- M. Palazzo – So, 1 year from now, we should have a complete project?
- J. Pastorius – Yes.
- M. Palazzo – Are the blue business signs part of the plan?
- J. Pastorius – Yes, the MOT indicated on page 28 of the plans indicates the signs.
- M. Palazzo – Is the plan for the contractor to meet with business owners to inform them of construction plans?
- J. Pastorius – Yes and we will also partner with the Palm City Chamber of Commerce.
- M. Palazzo – I would like to see signage showing the public that the CRA is responsible for this project and the CRA dollars at work. Could we post a rendering that shows the project map and updates?
- R. Sentell – Could we post the concept plans and maps in this building?
- J. Pastorius – I can ask Parks and Recreation if we can place the maps here.
- C. Smith – Will the general contractor have an office along Mapp Road? Maybe they could post the maps and have a station where people can stop by and look.
- J. Pastorius – They will have to station their work somewhere close.
- R. Sentell – What about the restaurant? Are they waiting to go forward with their project?
- J. Pastorius – Tucker Commons is very close to getting through the Development Review process.
- K. Natoli – So what was the outcome of our comments about the alley?
- J. Pastorius – Growth Management did not agree. One contributing factor was the unopened right of way between properties.
- K. Natoli – So our comments were ignored?
- J. Pastorius – They were considered but the Growth Management Director has the authority to make the final decision.
- J. Landrum – So who decided against the access?
- J. Pastorius – Growth Management.

OLD BUSINESS

Agenda Item: 20-0484, Staff Update

Jordan Pastorius, Senior Project Manager, Martin County Office of Community Development, presented a staff update.

Two of our future NAC meetings have been moved to the Cummings Library – April 20 and June 15. This building is going to be under renovation.

- J. Pastorius – The permit has been received. It will go out to bid late winter/early spring. We are applying for a 2nd grant that has been sent to the EPA and we are waiting to hear back.
