- D. Little Thank you we will investigate and correct the map.
- E. Anderson I want to go on the record to say that I do not want duplexes.
- D. Little You do have the option to have that conversation with us.
- J. Fransella The duplexes in Manatee Creek are trashed. How do we contain this?
- D. Little Sounds like a code enforcement issue.
- T. Perusi Have you driven down my street? I will meet you here and take you through so that you can see. There are condos going in across the street, another development and marinas.
- D. Little We are not taking away anyone's development rights.
- D. Little We will be back April 16th after taking these comments into consideration.
