Judge Mirman advised that as of January 31st that state approved funding for problem solving courses targeting Martin County adult and juvenile drug court.

Dr. Marshall advised that funding for kid programs was received as well. She also reported that the following trends were a concern: prescription abuse, legalizing marijuana and an increase in Kratom among juveniles.

Michelle Miller reported that two legislative bills in session are being monitored regarding raising the tobacco age limit to twenty-one (21).
