- B. Capps What are the future plans for Church Street? Will this mirror Jensen Beach Boulevard?
- J. Clasby The plan is to install a yield street with two lanes, streetlights, and landscaping. It will be
 like Camden Street in the City of Stuart, but not like Jensen Beach Boulevard. Church Street is more
 residential, and this configuration is in our vision plan for the Jensen Beach CRA.

OLD BUSINESS

Agenda Item: 22-0207, Port Salerno Affordable Housing RFP

Susan Kores, CRA Manager, presented the update.

- C. Hall Are these homes slated for rental or ownership?
- S. Kores Ownership.
- B. Capps Who pays for these homes?
- S. Kores The land is county owned and donated to the project. The homes are purchased by the owner.
- M. Readling Was the garage in the RFP? Did you specify the type of construction?
- S. Kores CBS construction, not sure about the garage. Will find out and get back to you.
- C. Winters Are these homes going to have impact windows?
- C. Hall These are relatively close to the new train and windows are very expensive to replace. So there are 8 lots and only 4 homes?
- S. Kores Yes.
- B. Capps How are the homes rewarded?
- S. Kores The builder that we chose will use organizations from this area to recruit homeowners.
- M. Readling Do you have any idea of what it would cost to build these?
- S. Kores We will have more information once we have an agreement in place.
- B. Capps Do they have to live in the house for a certain amount of time? How is the affordable housing maintained when a person sells their home?
- K. Storey The subsequent sales would have to remain affordable housing for 20 years.
- C. Hall Why is Habitat not involved?
- S. Kores They did not apply.
- C. Winters My question and concern is how is this program going to be held accountable for affordable housing?
- K. Storey This is new for the county. We have a draft agreement that we are working through. Our Human Services Department is conducting an on-going review of the current affordable housing project in Hobe Sound and I assume that they will do the same in Port Salerno.
- S. Kores This is purely a presentation for your information with more details to come.

Agenda Item: 22-0208, Dixie Highway Resurfacing Project

Susan Kores, CRA Manager, presented the update.

- B. Capps Is the septic to sewer project mandatory for the residents to hook up?
- S. Kores The residents will have 365 days to connect to the sewer. The utilities department will have loan programs and finance help as well.
- C. Hall We are going through this process in Jensen Beach right now. If you hook up during the first 365 days, you can save around \$2,000.
- B. Capps I see that the road to your home is the homeowner's responsibility, but what about the overall project and the big pipes in the road? Is this the homeowner's responsibility as well?
- S. Tsaftarides Golden Gate acquired a grant that paid for part of the conversion. I'm not sure what the other CRA's have done.
- B. Capps So the projects are paid for in a variety of ways?
- K. Storey The utilities department does a great job in applying for grants and making the connection as affordable as possible.
- S. Kores For the next CRA meeting, I will bring the details of each CRA and how their water and sewer projects are funded.
