The idea here is to make sure that everyone is refreshed and kept current on the procedures even if they have been through the process before.

Agenda Item: 21-0627, Alternative Compliance 2555 SE Bonita Street

Irene Szedlmayer, Principal Planner presented the alternative compliance for the commercial property located at 2555 SE Bonita Street.

- A. Lichterman I am the business owner of Vessel Ready. My business took off in November, became
 very successful and I would like to rent the other half of the building when the car dealership moves out.
 I am interested in working with the community and keeping them happy by following the rules.
- C. Ramsey Irene, you are happy with the expansion as long as the conditions are met as stated in the staff report?
- I. Szedlmayer Yes, the two conditions in the report must be met.
- S. Tsaftarides We have had a problem with this corner in the past.
- A. Lichterman I have plans and have been working with my landlord to make sure we are not bothering the community. We want to make you happy.
- C. Ramsey Who is supposed to replace the fence?
- J. Vitale Irene, you recommend denial of this alternative compliance, but would recommend approval if they meet the conditions is this correct?
- I. Szedlmayer Yes, if the fence is improved and the gate is kept closed, I would recommend approval.
 This is to say that all the boat inventory stays on their lot unless a delivery arrives and stays in the staging area temporarily.
- C. Ramsey Could we put the conditions in the lease?
- A. Lichterman We plan to stay within the property and below the fence line so you will not see boats.
- J. Vitale I think that we were burned so badly by the previous tenant that we are apprehensive about another alternative compliance and the tenant following the rules.
- C. Ramsey I believe that by expanding your business to the rest of the building, this will solve the issue of overflow.
- I. Szedlmayer The landlord and the tenant realize that they have to be good neighbors and follow the rules.
- A. Lichterman This is my first experience as a business owner, and I am doing my best to communicate and make sure that the neighborhood is happy with me.
- T. Tsaftarides I would like to see the landlord come to the NAC meeting and present their plan.
- I. Szedlmayer We met with the owner last week and he did offer to come in. We did not feel that it was
 necessary to spend the time and gas to attend since he lives in Miami and we made him aware of the
 rules.
