## BACKGROUND/RELATED STRATEGIC GOAL:

In 2012, Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) announced they had an agreement to allow high-speed rail to construct railroad tracks on existing FEC owned right-of-way from Miami to Orlando. The initial high-speed rail project called All Aboard Florida began dual tracking in Miami and moving north. A station was completed in West Palm Beach, the company was named Brightline and has been continuing the dual tracks to the north through Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River and Brevard counties. Commission Chair, Doug Smith, has requested a presentation by Brightline to

update the Board of County Commissioners (Board) on the status of the project.

#### ISSUES:

The County has received complaints from residents and businesses when the railroad crossings have been closed due to Brightline. The County has no control over Brightline and their scheduled closures. The land provided to allow for a road to cross over railroad tracks, is owned by FEC, not the County.
