Industrial Development Authority Vacancies

The Martin County Board of County Commissioners is seeking applications from individuals interested in being considered for appointment to fill vacancies on the **Industrial Development Authority**. All individuals serve without compensation and are requested to submit an Application for Appointment to Martin County Administration **by Friday, July 31, 2026**. The Industrial Development Authority was created pursuant to Chapter 159 of the Florida Statutes and is responsible for financing and refinancing projects for the public purposes described in "The Florida Industrial Development Financing Act", Florida Statutes, and for the purposes of fostering the economic development of a County.

THREE VACANT POSITIONS: All members must be residents and registered voters in Martin County. The terms will end September 14, 2028, 2029, and 2030, and the appointed individuals can re-apply.

Meetings are held every other month at 2:00 pm at the Administrative Center (2401 SE Monterey Road, Stuart). The next few meetings are September 11 and November 13. The Liaison for the Authority is the Business Development Board.

Florida law prohibits an advisory board member from doing business with its agency (the County). Section 112.313(3) and (7), Fla. Stat.

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
