**AUTHORIZING PERMISSION TO APPLY FOR A SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SSR4A)
SUPPLEMENTAL PLANNING GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
(DOT) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE SE BRIDGE ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY AND ROAD
SAFETY AUDIT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners has made the following determinations of fact:

1. The Martin County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) will request funding assistance from the DOT for the SE Bridge Road Corridor Study and Road Safety Audit project, which provides for joint responsibilities of DOT and the County and will deliver such application to DOT.
2. Martin County has legal ownership of all designated rights-of-way within the project limits of the SE Bridge Road Corridor Study and Road Safety Audit project.
3. The Board has determined that it is appropriate to enter into an appropriate Agreement with DOT and will commit to local match funding of the project in the amount of \$70,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Martin County, Florida:

- A. The Board hereby authorizes the Director of the Martin County Public Works Department, or designee, to sign and deliver to DOT the FY26 SSR4A Supplemental Planning Grant Application request for funding assistance for the SE Bridge Road Corridor Study and Road Safety Audit project.
